

Friday June 12 - Human Life International Representative to visit Caribbean



Dr Brian Clowes, Director of Research and Training for Human Life International (HLI), will be visiting the Caribbean from 1 – 10 July. Inter alia, he hopes

- a) to stand in solidarity with and to strengthen the resolve of those committed to promote a culture of life from conception to natural death;
- b) to increase networking opportunities for those involved in pro-life work in the Caribbean;
- c) to share information and strategies for creating a culture that will recognize human dignity and enable each individual to achieve his/her potential.

HLI's website: www.hli.org states that Dr Clowes has worked full-time as Director of Research and Training for HLI "for more than eleven years after working as a systems analyst for the federal government and, before that, as a team leader in the United States Army Special Forces... A 1974 graduate of West Point, Brian holds a Ph.D. in Systems Science, and is married to the former Kathy Krynock. They have seven children. Dr. Clowes has travelled more than a million kilometers to 35 countries training and organizing pro-life groups and giving talks on a variety of subjects all over the world."

Dr Clowes has written a number of books and articles. His articles "cover many different subjects and have appeared in a wide variety of publications." His itinerary in the Caribbean is as follows:

- 1st July pm - 4 July am : Trinidad (This will be his 4th visit to T&T).
- 4 July am - 5 July pm : Barbados
- 5 July pm - 7 July pm : St Lucia
- 7 July pm - 9 July pm : Grenada
- 9 July pm - 10 July am : Trinidad

The Catholic Commission for Social Justice, Emmanuel Community and Living Water Community are involved in planning Dr Clowes' Caribbean visit.

While in T&T opportunities will be provided for Dr Clowes to meet with interested groups e.g. a Seminar entitled: *Building a Culture of Life in the 21st Century* is being organized for him to meet with pro-life groups.
